What is KBART?

Purpose

Standardized format for content providers to communicate holdings metadata to libraries and knowledge base suppliers

History

Recommended practice published 2010, updated 2014 KBART Automation RP 2019 Phase III revision underway since 2020

Major work items

Clarified recommendations from Phase II Model license language promoting KBART File manifest requirement describing delivered KBART files **New fields** to support diverse content types and languages **Delivery formats** other than tab-delimited text **Endorsement process** with clarified focus and procedures Article-/chapter-level data roadmap


