- International Association of Scientific, Technical and Medical Publishers
- Includes academic and professional publishers, learned societies, and university presses; established players as well as start-ups
- Over **140 members**, in over 20 countries around the world, covering **all scholarly disciplines**
- STM members collectively publish **66% of journal articles** and **10,000's of monographs and reference works**
- STM supports its members in advancing **trusted research** worldwide.
- STM works together to serve science and society by developing **standards and technology** to ensure research is of high quality, trustworthy and easy to access

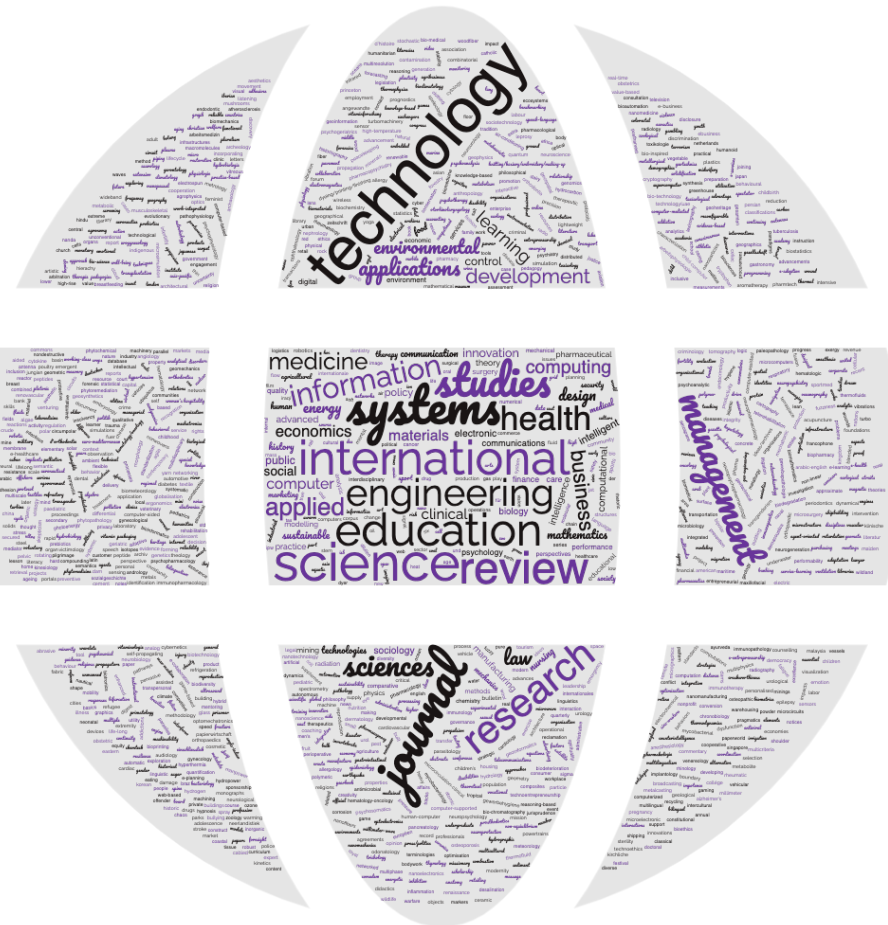
# Introducing STM Solutions

## Research is global

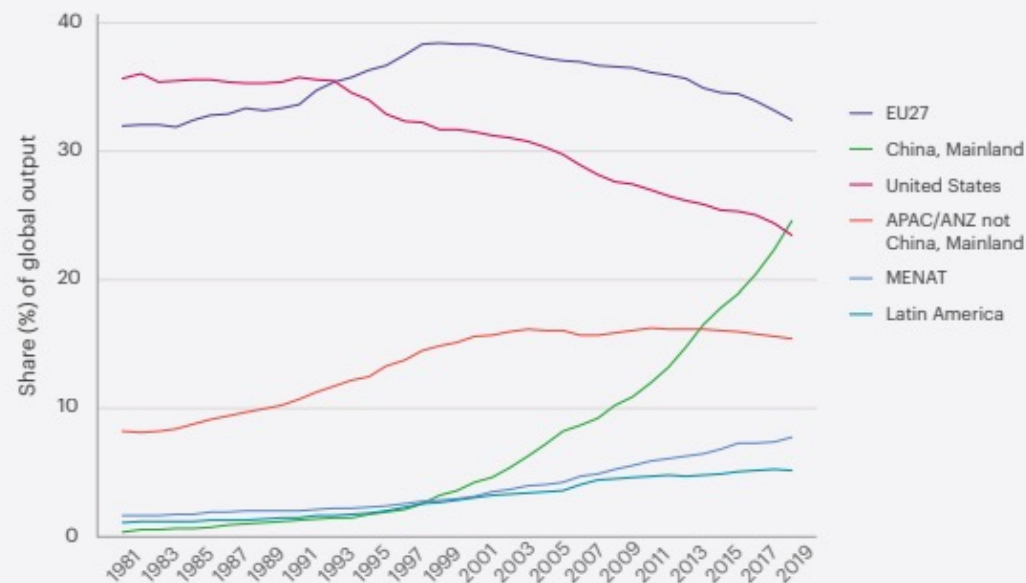
- A lot of research – e.g. most STEM fields – is international in nature

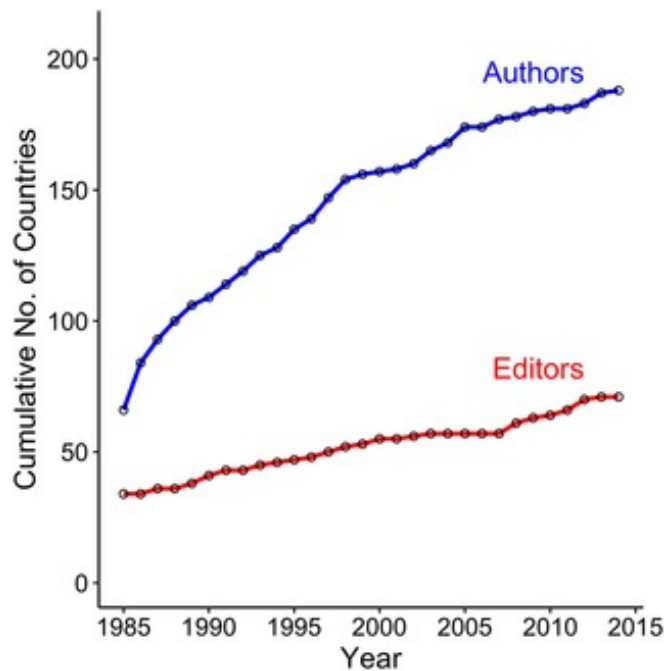

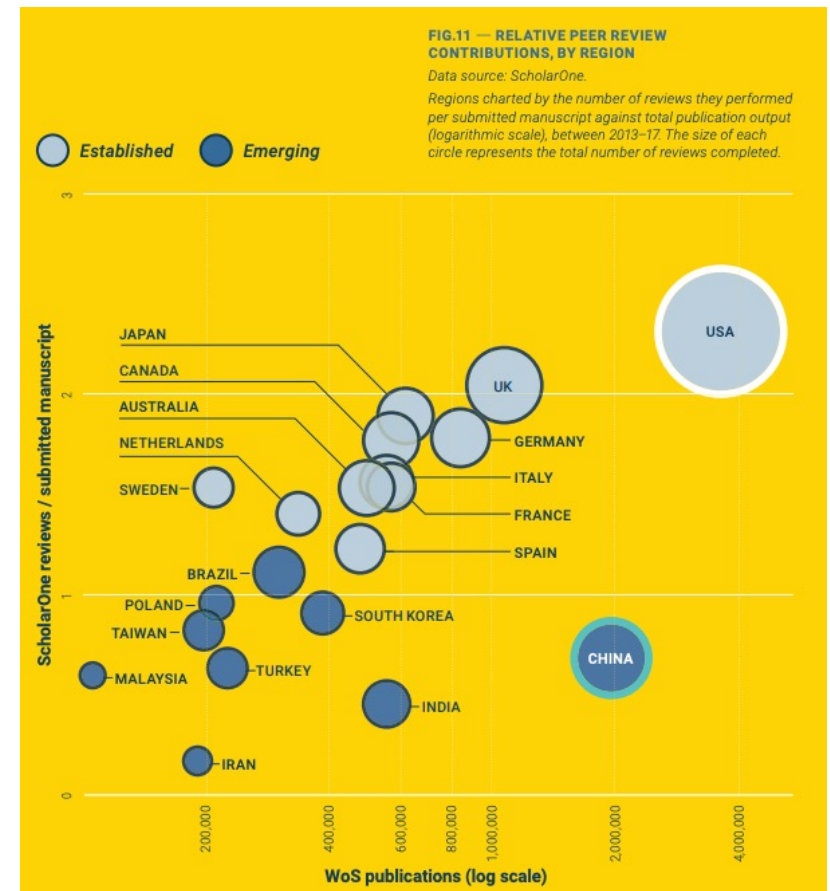

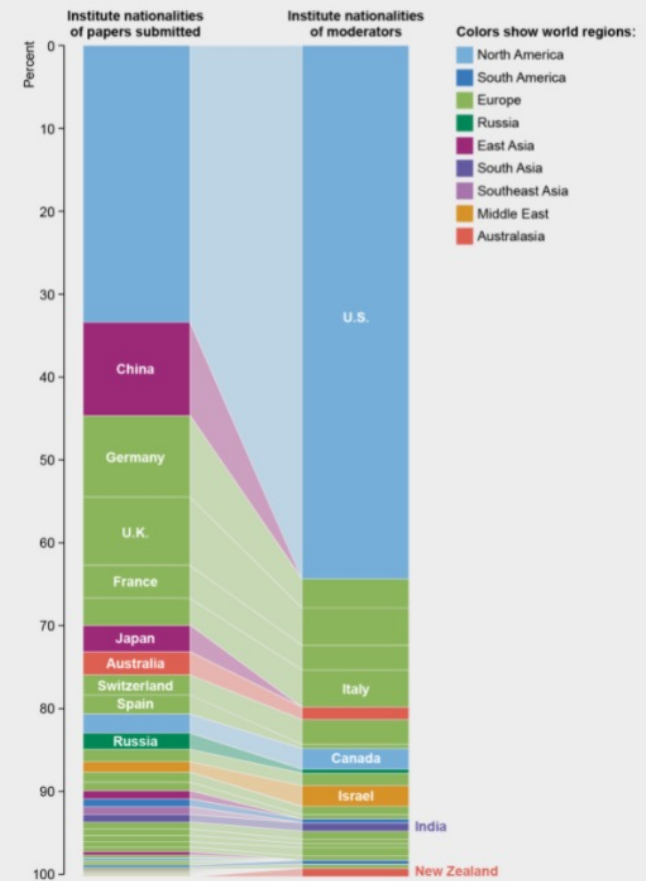

## ArXiv's Moderator Mismatch

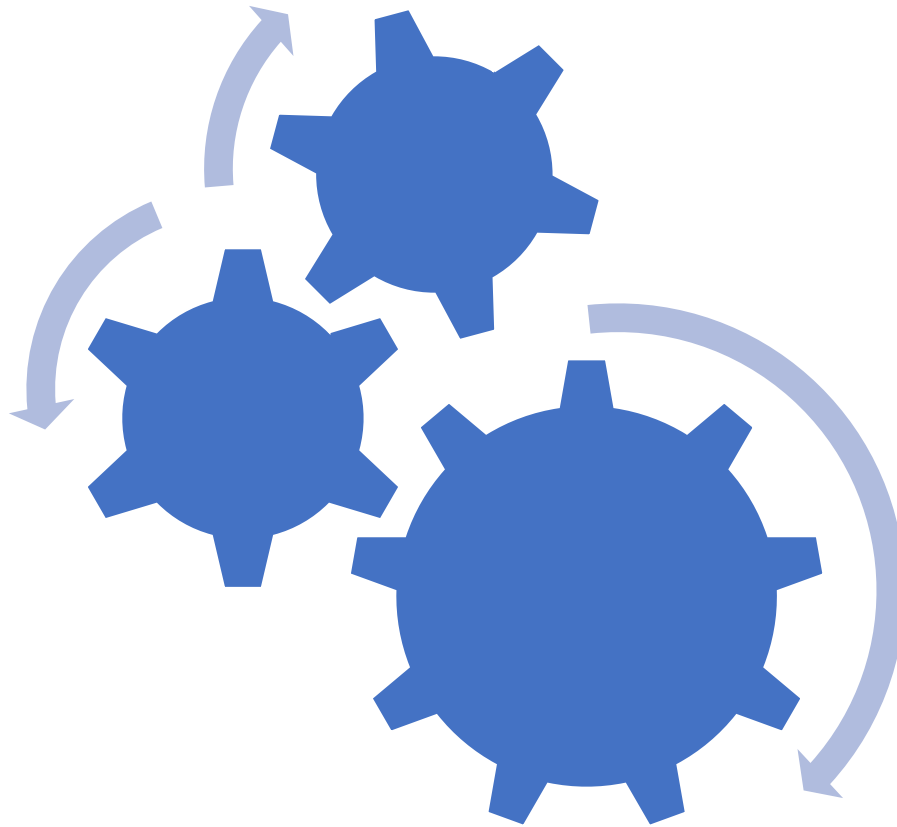
Despite arXiv.org being the world's top repository for scientific preprints, the moderators who accept or reject submissions are overwhelmingly composed of researchers from the U.S. and Europe. Such imbalances can pose challenges for editorial fairness.

The paper submission data below include the 400 institutions that submitted the most papers, on average, from 2018 through 2020. Moderator data are current as of December 23, 2021.

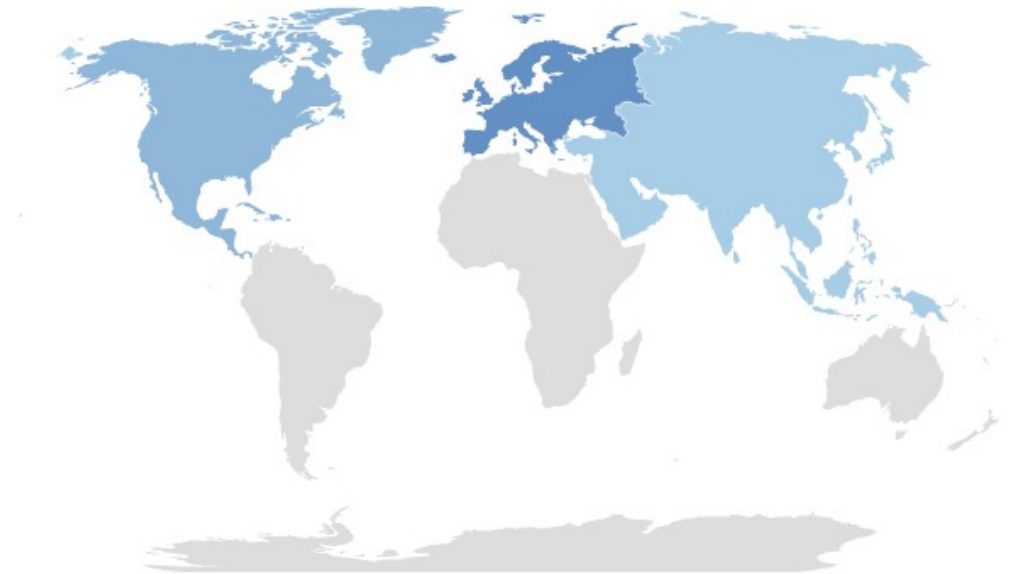

- Service that accelerates the discovery and access of authoritative, trusted research
- Signals users' entitlements on discovery services and removes friction in the authentication process.

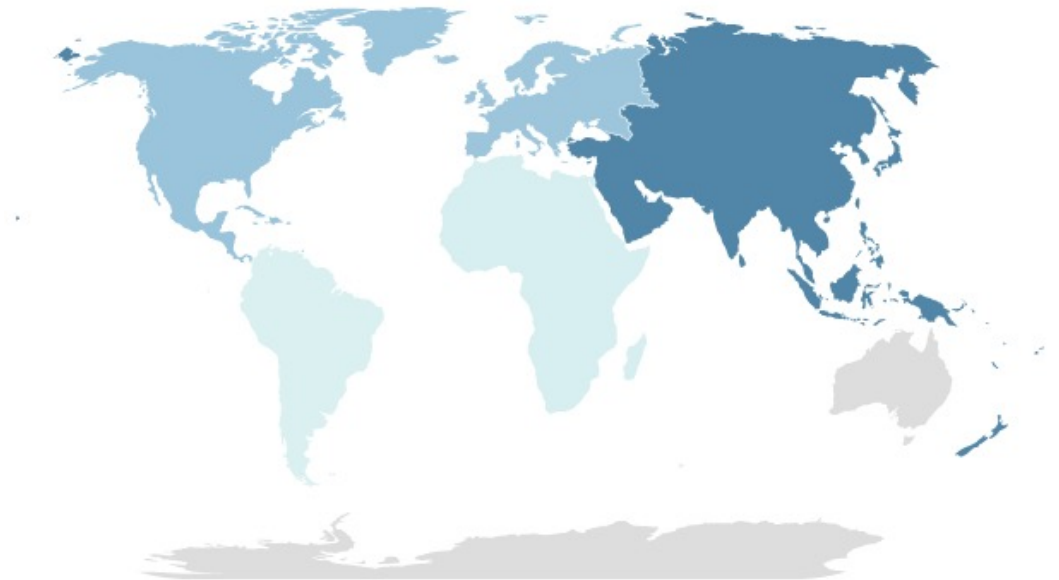

*GetFTR entitlement signaling helps the user to see which content they are entitled to*



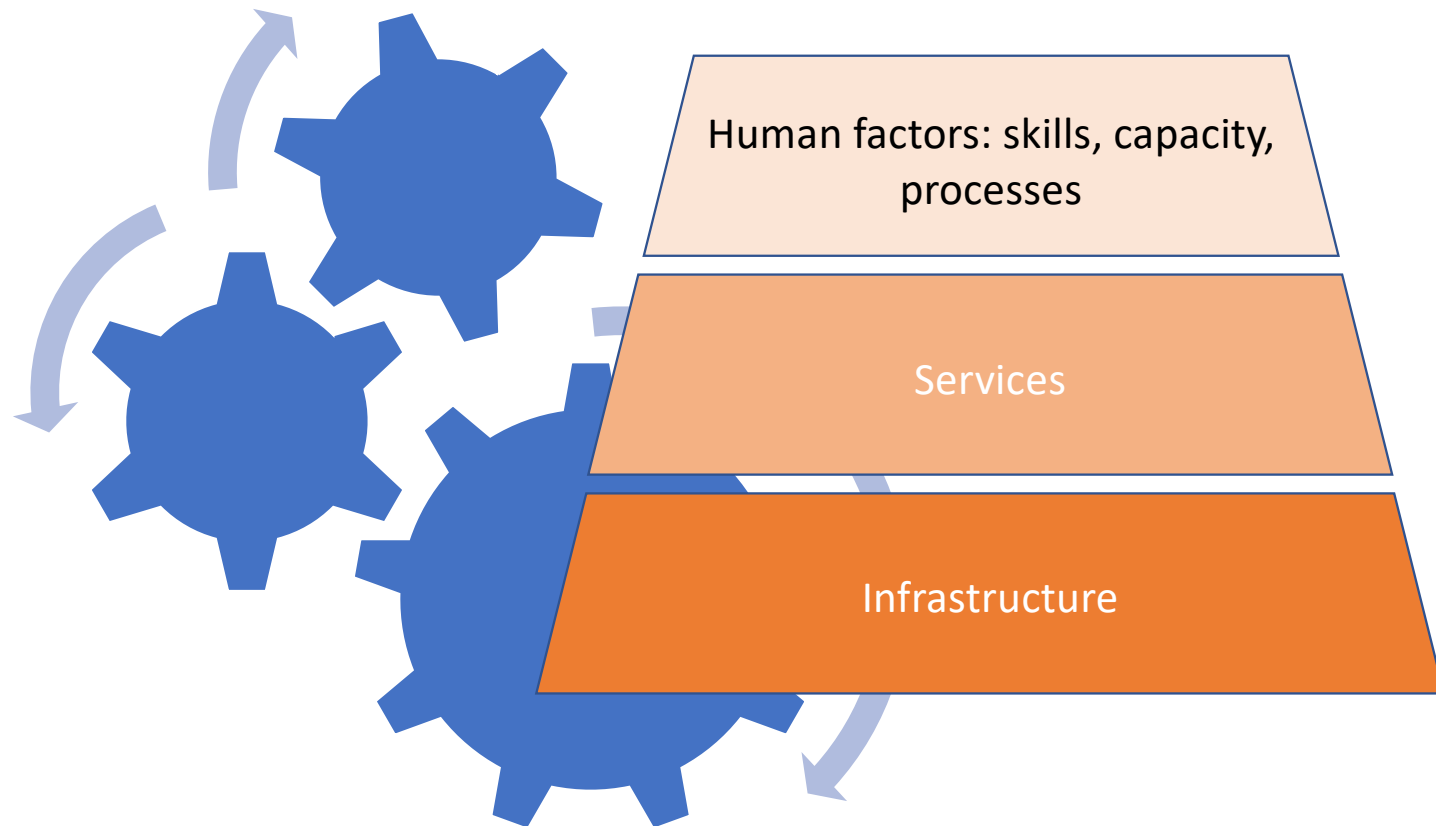

**GetFTR utilisation per region**



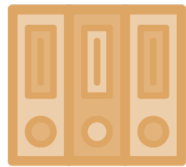

- Research4Life aims to reduce the knowledge gap between industrialized countries and developing countries by providing **affordable access** to **academic and professional resources**.
