



- Cost-per-use for funded content



HOW COUNTER FACILITATES OA REPORTING

WHERE IT IS NOT POSSIBLE TO IDENTIFY USAGE BY INDIVIDUAL INSTITUTIONS, IT SHOULD BE ATTRIBUTED TO "THE WORLD"




